Beneficiaries aged 40 - 49 (every 2 years)

HIV pathology test

Beneficiaries 15 and older (every 5 years)



Dexa bone density scan*

Beneficiaries 50 and older (every 3 years)

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Mammogram*

Women 38 and older (every 2 years)



Pap smear

Women 15 and older (annually)

(Consultation and pathology test)



Maternity benefit

Up to 12 antenatal visits 2 scans

Up to 3 nurse home visits facilitated through Baby Yum Yum

2 paediatrician visits* for babies up to 12 months

Register from the 8th week of your pregnancy

Vaccines

Tetanus diphtheria

(all beneficiaries)

Pneumococcal*

(beneficiaries 60 and older and high-risk beneficiaries)

Flu (children between 6 months and 5 years, beneficiaries 65 and older and high-risk beneficiaries)

Child immunisation (as stipulated by DOH) Children up to age 6. Ingwe Option members should make use of State baby clinics



Prostate specific antigen test

Men aged 40 - 49 (every 5 years)
Men aged 50 - 59 (every 3 years)
Men aged 60 - 69 (every 2 years)
Men 70 and older (annually)
